STEPS TO INSTALL SKYPE







In the screen appeared choose **Get Skype for Windows**.





The installation file is downloaded on your computer in the form of an executable file (Skypesetup.exe).

Double click on the executable file **skypesetup.exe** and then select **RUN** on the window appeared.





Right after, the installation of the application on your computer begins.

The installation will be completed after following simple steps, through which you will be asked to select communication language (e.g. Greek). At the

final step choose Install.

As soon as the installation is completed, a window to connect to Skype will appear.
