Open a web browsing application (e.g. Google Chrome) by double-clicking on the icon .




Type YouTube web address (<u>www.youtube.com</u>), as shown in the picture below. .




Through the web browsing application you will be redirected at YouTube website, with the YouTube distinctive logo.







To search for a video, type the title in the search field of the page:











Some actions and settings to have in mind when watching a video are the following:

⇒ To change sound volume choose the speaker-like icon


